## What We Can Do For You

### Inquiry Line

You can call us, locally or toll-free, for answers to general legal questions, referrals to services, support, and information. Our staff is friendly and knowledgeable. This service is completely confidential and you do not need to tell us your name.

### Lawyer Referral Service

Island lawyers volunteer to provide 30 minute consultations for people who have legal questions or need basic legal advice. There is a nominal fee of \$10 plus taxes for this service. This service depends on the generosity of Island lawyers who donate their time and expertise.

### Publications

We have over 60 CLIA publications on federal and provincial laws, as well as publications produced by other organizations. All are available free of charge. Topics range from buying property on PEI to child support to being an executor for an estate.
